

Residential at Doncaster Vic Rooftop Garden Waterproofing Melbourne

Project Details

A waterproofing job completed by Findlay-Evans Waterproofing for an apartment block with a rooftop garden area in Melbourne, VIC. The building was leaking, and the original builders abandoned the project, leaving the residents to fix it themselves. Findlay-Evans team's approach involved a cost-effective treatment that enhanced the appearance and functionality of the space.

Location & problem:

Doncaster Rd, Doncaster Vic 3108

The building was leaking throughout, and the original builders ran off.

Solution & Approach:

Findlay-Evans <u>Waterproofing</u> proposed going over the top of the tiles instead of removing them, using a liquid rubber base coating.

The job involved stripping the entire <u>balcony</u> area, cleaning out the planter boxes, grinding the surfaces, and applying coatings.

A thermal reflective top coat was applied with three coats, and the planter boxes were treated with Arma Blue.

The installation of synthetic glass and synthetic grass in planter boxes was described.



Results:

The finished job looks attractive, and the customers were happy with the result.

The project provides a comprehensive overview of the waterproofing process, showcasing the expertise and attention to detail that went into this particular project. It serves as a testament to the quality of work that can be expected from the contractor.
